How long does it take?

Completion of the course is in your own time using our online portal. On average the course will take you approximately 4 hours to work through and then complete a 1 hour assessment

What will you get when you complete?

If you successfully complete the course you will receive a nationally recognised Statement of Attainment for the Unit TLIF2080 Safely access the rail corridor and TLIB3118 Apply awareness of railway fundamentals from the Transport & Logistics Industry Training Package.

What Next?

Before Training

- 1. This is an online training course, you will need access to the internet.**
- 2. You need to use Google Chrome to access the internet as the program will not work properly with other web browsers.**
- To work on the rail corridor, you need to pass a medical, we do recommend that you obtain your category 1, 2, or 3 medical before you do the training. A Cat 1, 2, or 3 medical must be done by an approved Health Provider. It is recommended that you obtain your category 1,2,or 3 medical before you do the training. A Cat 1,2,or 3 medical must be done by an approved Health Provider. A list of Approved Health Providers can be found at <https://www.riw.net.au/authorised-health-professionals/#find-an-ahp>. Please note that we do not need to sight the medical. But we will not refund monies from failed medicals as it is essential that you obtain this document to work within the rail corridor. This medical is then uploaded to the RIW (rail Industry Worker Card).
- 4. Unique Student Identifier (USI) Number.** From January 2015, the Australian Government implemented that all students participating in nationally recognised training need to have a USI. Your USI gives you access to an online record of your training that has been completed since January 2015. You will be able to access these results throughout your life. Students who do not currently have a USI must obtain one before attending training at Go-Train Industry. **Please visit www.usi.gov.au to obtain your USI.** We need you to provide us with your USI number as we cannot issue your certificate until the USI number is received.
- To secure your spot in the course you need to enrol and pay for your course prior to commencement of training – this is done through the Go-Train website.

During the course

- You will be required to complete multiple choice questions and scenario-based assessments for this course.

After Training

1. On completion of the training you will have an understanding of rail industry terminology, basic signalling indications, rules and regulations for people working in the rail corridor, knowledge of a safe place, electrical safety, personal and legal requirements of fatigue, drugs and alcohol.
2. **Statement of Attainment** - If you successfully complete you will receive a nationally recognised Statement of Attainment for the Units TLIF2080 Safely access the rail corridor and TLIB3118 Apply awareness of railway fundamentals.
3. **Rail Industry Work (RIW) Card** - You will need to obtain a Rail Industry Work (RIW) Card to work in the rail industry – this is the national competency management system for rail workers. Please refer to the <https://www.riw.net.au/> website for further information.
