

3.15 QR Working in the Electrified Territory (QR WET) Reaccreditation

Course Description

Queensland Rail requires all holders of the QR Electric Traction Safety Card (Green) card and QR WET certification to have their qualification re-certified every three (3) years, before it expires.

This course is aligned to the specific requirements of Queensland Rail Network rules and procedures for Working in the Electrified Territory.

It is designed to test the participant's ongoing knowledge and practical skills as per their initial training and assessment in the QR WET course.

No licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply to this course at the time of publication.



Award received on completion:

On successful completion of this course learners will obtain a reissued non-accredited Queensland Rail enterprise qualification.



Cost:

Refresher training and re-assessment: \$200 per person.

Alternative costs apply for group or onsite training, contact Go-Train to discuss.



Duration:

Refresher training and re-assessment: Up to 4 hours.



Work Placement Requirements:

There is no work placement requirement for this short course.



Personal Protective Equipment Requirements:

Participants must provide their own:

- ankle-high steel cap boots
- rail approved long-sleeved hi-vis shirt or hi-vis vest over long-sleeved shirt
- long pants



Entry Requirements:

This course may not be suitable for everyone. Participants must have:

- a current valid QR Electric Traction Safety Card (Green) card and
- RIW card showing currency for the QR WET certification
- **Note:** If a QR Electric Traction Safety Card (Green) card has expired, the participant is not eligible to complete a recertification. Expired certifications must be completed in full by attending the full QR WET course.

Language, Literacy and Numeracy

Where a participant is deemed, either prior to enrolment or throughout the training program, to possess a lower level of language, literacy or numeracy skills than is the minimum requirement for the course, Go-Train Industry will provide advice and support to the participant regarding further learning options.

At times, additional language or literacy development or remedial assistance may be required prior to the continuation or completion of the participant's course of study. The cost of this further LLN development or remedial assistance would need to be covered by the participant.



What Next?

Before training:

- To secure a spot in the course participants need to enrol and pay for the course prior to commencement of training. Please contact Go-Train to discuss payment options.
- Participants must provide a copy of their valid current RIW card and QR Electric Traction Safety Card (Green) card before attending the course.

On the day of training:

- Bring your RIW Card, QR Electric Traction Safety Card (Green) card and Photo ID, preferably a driver's licence showing full name, date of birth and address.
- **Participants must wear covered in shoes.** Please note that we have a **NO THONGS** policy and individuals will be sent home if the correct footwear is not worn.
- Course fees must already be paid in full before attending each stage.

At the course:

- When participants attend training, they will be asked to sign a Training Attendance Sheet. Signing the attendance sheet is an acknowledgement that they have read and understood this Pre-Training Information prior to attending the course.
- This course will be delivered in a classroom and non-live rail environment by a qualified and experienced Rail Trainer.
- All learning materials will be provided to participants.
- Theory assessments must be completed for this course.



After Assessment:

- **Certificate of Achievement** – On successful completion, participants will receive a Certificate of Achievement for QR 3.15 Working in the Electrified Territory – Reaccreditation.
- **Rail Industry Work (RIW) Card** – On completion of the course, Go-Train will update participant's RIW profile with the achieved certification. Please refer to the <https://www.riw.net.au/> website or contact us for further information.
